Modena Enzo Ferrari museum delivers a unique and enthralling museum experience that takes visitors back to the roots of the world's most famous car make. Topped by a striking yellow car bonnet-inspired roof that stands out against Modena skyline, not only does the Museum tell the story of Ferrari's founding father but it also showcases some of the most beautiful cars ever built. Modena Museum Enzo Ferrari also encompasses the former workshop of Enzo Ferrari's father which has been meticulously restored and now houses the Museum of Ferrari Engines where visitors can see the Prancing Horse's most experimental power units as well as the perfect engines that equip the track and road cars which have given great satisfaction to both Ferrari and its "tifosi" (supporters). https://musei.ferrari.com/it/modena
